A few years back, Mrs. Maxwell paid to have her roof replaced. The job was never finished and the contractor disappeared.

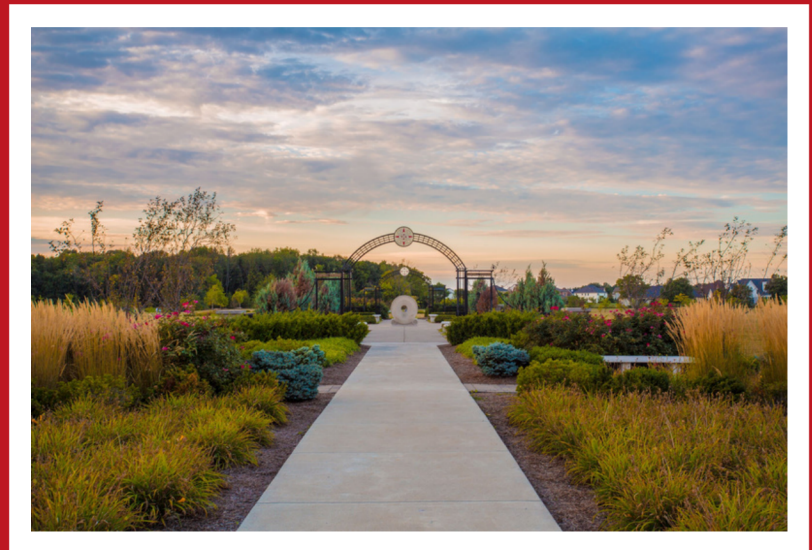
We made it right at no charge to Mrs. Maxwell.

Universal Cares hosted their annual golf outing with the wonderful people and facility at Brookshire Golf Course. It was a day full of fun, food, and fundraising!



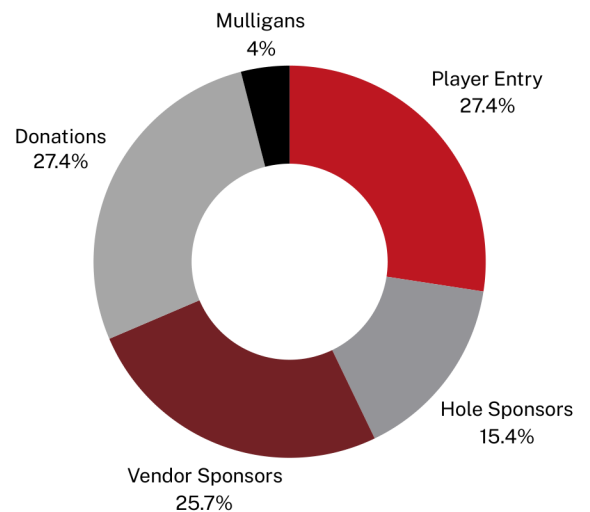

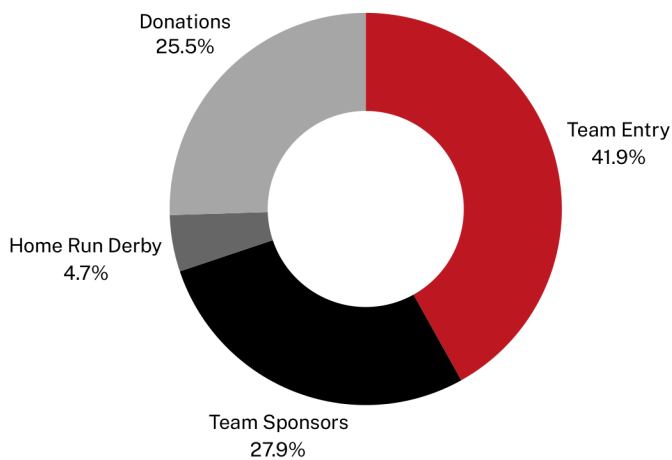

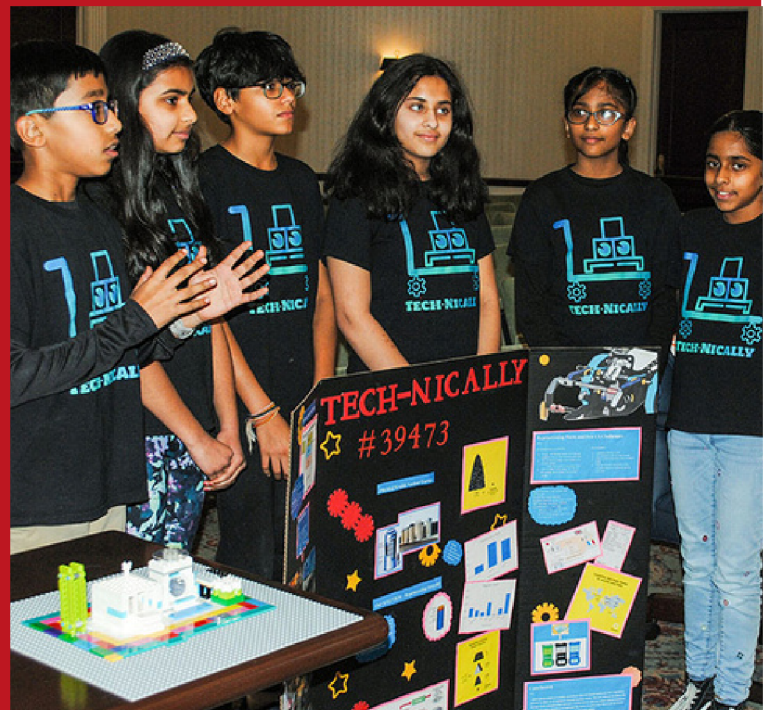
